BRITISH CYCLING

British Cycling has 3 levels of membership as below. It is recommended that club members do not consider the Bronze option as the benefits are minimal.

The Gold and Silver options give Legal Advice & Support and 3rd Party (Public) Liability Insurance. The Gold Option gives Personal Accident Insurance whilst riding at any time and the Silver option gives Personal Accident Insurance only while participating in a British Cycling event
